WHAT IS THE PURPOSE AND LEGAL BASIS OF THE PROCESSING

Your personal data, as well as personal data of people contacting us in your name, collected at the moment of concluding and performing of contracts for supplying goods or services for us, are processed for the following purposes and on legal grounds as follows:

- 1) **to prepare, conclude and perform a contract with the controller**, for the duration of a contract and its settlement afterwards on the basis of article 6 par. 1.b GDPR (hereafter referred to as "performance of a contract");
- 2) **compliance with all legal obligations imposed on us**, such as issuing and storing of invoices, carrying out warranties claims and similar claims, evidencing transactions etc., for the time necessary to comply with such obligations until such obligations expire or become unenforceable on the basis of article 6 par. 1.c GDPR (hereafter referred to as "legal obligation");
- 3) **determining, protecting and enforcing any of our rights**, including assignment of claims against you to third parties, for the time no longer than limitation period on the basis of article 6 par. 1.f GDPR (hereafter referred to as "legitimate interest"); or for the time necessary to carry out obligations regarding evidencing of transactions on the basis of legal obligation.
- 4) **carry out summaries, analysis, statistics**, for the time necessary to carry out such activities on the basis of legitimate interest;
- 5) **direct marketing of our products and services,** for the period until your withdrawal of consent only subject to purposes set out in your separate consent.

We collect and process personal data for other purpose than above only upon your expressed consent and only within the scope of such consent. You are entitled to withdraw the consent at any time, however the withdrawal of the consent will not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

WHAT PERSONAL DATA WE PROCESS?

At the moment of concluding a contract we request you to provide us with personal data indicated in an order or standard contract forms (if your do not provide us with these data, we will not conclude a contract), regardless if we use standard contract or order forms in a particular situation. These personal data may include but are not limited to your name, surname, identification number regarding your business, e-mail address, data necessary to carry out payment (eq. your bank account number).

The provision of the above personal data **is voluntary**, however necessary for us to enter into and afterwards to perform of a contract.

SHARING OF THE INFORMATION WE RECEIVE

We share your personal information with:

- 1) **processors processing data on our behalf** with regards to activities rendered on our behalf:
 - a) purchasing agents and other intermediaries in the process of purchasing goods and services;
 - b) suppliers of marketing services for us;
 - c) administrators of our IT systems and providing us with IT tools and resources;
 - d) sub-contractors helping us in performing a contract, for example custom agents, carriers;
 - e) advisors, consultants, auditors, legal and tax advisors, accountants etc.
- 2) **other controllers** processing data in their own name:
 - a) purchasing agents and other intermediaries in the process of purchasing goods and services to settle their remuneration;
 - b) couriers and post offices;
 - c) payment institutions to process any payments from or to you;
 - d) assignees in case of assignment of claims that we may have against you;

THE PERIOD OF PROCESSING

Particular periods of processing of your personal data by us are indicated in the description of purposes and legal basis of our processing above.

TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA OUTSIDE EUROPEAN ECONOMIC AREA (EEA)

We currently do not intend to transfer your personal data outside of the European Economic Area.

AUTHOMATED INDIVIDUAL DECISION MAKING

We do not issue any decision basing on automated data processing which produces a legal effect concerning you or considerably affects you.

YOUR RIGHTS

GDPR gives you following rights in relation to your personal data:

- accessing your personal data (including receiving copies of them) under article 15 GDPR;
- 2) correcting your personal data under article 16 GDPR;
- 3) deleting your personal data under article 17 GDPR;
- 4) to demand restriction of processing under article 18 GDPR;
- 5) to demand transmission of personal data under article 20 GDPR.

We may require additional information enabling us to verify your identity and your right to enforce the above rights.

RIGHT TO OBJECT

Apart from rights referred to in preceding paragraphs, you have the right to object, at any time, to processing of your personal data by us (including profiling) for direct marketing purpose. After filing the objection, we will restrain from processing your data for this purpose.

You have also right to object, on grounds relating to your particular situation, at any time to processing of your personal data which is based on legitimate interest or public interest (including profiling). The controller shall no longer process the personal data unless the controller demonstrates compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject or for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims.

COMPLAINT
